
RHYTHM REB<u>ELS</u>



OMFS, RTA Awareness Week

The Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at Santosh Dental College and Hospital, in collaboration with the Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons of India (AOMSI), organized a three-day Road Trauma Awareness Campaign. The primary objective of the campaign was to raise awareness about road safety, reduce road trauma, and emphasize the importance of oral and maxillofacial surgery in the context of road accidents. The first day of the campaign focused on conducting educational workshops and seminars within the college premises. The second day was dedicated to hands-on training and simulations. Participants had the opportunity to engage in practical exercises, such as emergency response simulations, first aid training, and understanding the role of oral and maxillofacial surgeons in the aftermath of road accidents.
