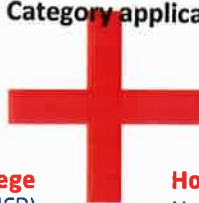

Report on Health Screening Camp by department of biochemistry and General Medicine in collaboration with Delhi Diabetic Forum

Venue: 1st floor, OPD area, Dept of General Medicine, Santosh Hospital

Date: 13.3.2024

Time: 10:00 am-4:00pm

Introduction: In adherence to the guidelines set forth by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), the Departments of General Medicine and Biochemistry jointly organized a comprehensive health screening camp. This collaborative effort aimed to raise awareness about metabolic disorders, diabetes, cardiovascular diseases, and Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Disease (NAFLD) on the occasion of World Obesity Day. The camp took place on 13th March 2024, from 10:00 AM to 04:00 PM, at the First Floor OPD/Lobby Area of Santosh Hospital, Ghaziabad (Delhi NCR).

Objective: The primary objective of the camp was to offer a wide array of diagnostic facilities to individuals, enabling early detection, prevention, and management of various metabolic and lifestyle-related diseases. While the Medicine Department handled certain aspects, the Biochemistry Department played a pivotal role in providing specialized tests crucial for diagnosing and monitoring these conditions.

Facilities Offered: Under the collaborative efforts of both departments, with the Medicine Department overseeing certain components and the Biochemistry Department focusing on specialized tests, the following facilities were provided:

1. **Weight and Height Measurements:** Essential anthropometric measurements were conducted jointly to assess overall health and nutritional status.
2. **Spot Uric Acid Test:** The spot uric acid tests, supported by Mr. Manoj Tyagi, Senior Lab Supervisor, and the team of senior lab technicians including Mr. Mahendra and Mr. Bishm from the Biochemistry Department, efficiently screening for conditions like gout and kidney disease.
3. **Liver Function Test (Free):** The Biochemistry Department, led by Dr. Eram Hussain Pasha, conducted comprehensive liver function tests to evaluate liver health, which is crucial for detecting NAFLD. Mr. Manoj Tyagi, along with Mr. Mahendra and Mr. Bishm, ensured the smooth operation of this essential screening.
4. **Spot Lipid Profile:** Another vital aspect handled by the Biochemistry Department was the spot lipid profile test, to assess cardiovascular risk.

5. **Random Blood Glucose (RBS) Test:** The Biochemistry Department, conducted random blood glucose tests to screen for elevated blood sugar levels, a hallmark of diabetes, with the proficient support of the entire team.
6. **Spot HbA1C Test:** Dr. Eram Hussain Pasha, Mr. Manoj Tyagi, Mr. Mahendra, Mr. Bhishm, and the team efficiently conducted spot HbA1C tests to measure glycosylated hemoglobin levels, crucial for assessing long-term blood sugar control in diabetes.

Other components such as BMI calculation, CBC analysis, ECG screening, liver stiffness measurement by Fibroscan, blood pressure measurement, and physician consultation were managed by the Medicine Department.

Conclusion: The collaborative effort between the Medicine Department and the Biochemistry Department ensured the success of the health screening camp, adhering to NAAC guidelines. The specialized tests conducted by the Biochemistry Department, under the guidance of Dr. Eram Hussain Pasha and supported by dedicated personnel like Mr. Manoj Tyagi, Mr. Mahendra, and Mr. Bhishm, played a crucial role in providing comprehensive diagnostic facilities. This joint endeavor underscored the commitment of both departments to promoting community health and well-being through early detection and intervention strategies.

Special acknowledgment and credits are due to Dr. Juhi Aggarwal, Professor and Head, Department of Biochemistry, Santosh Medical College and Hospital SDTU, for her guidance and support in organizing and coordinating the collaborative camp with the Medicine Department. Without her leadership and expertise, this camp wouldn't have been as successful in fulfilling its objectives.

Preface: A free health camp was organised on 23rd August 2023, in Specialized Adoption Agency, Gharonda orphanage, Ghaziabad, by Department of Community Medicine, Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad.

Collaboration: Specialized Adoption Agency, Gharonda orphanage, Ghaziabad

Execution:

- A free health camp was organized on 23rd August 2023, in **Specialized Adoption Agency**, Gharonda orphanage, Ghaziabad, by Department of Community Medicine, Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad.
- A total of **27 children** were examined.
- The clinical findings were noted on OPD cards which had the stamp of 'health camp'.
- All the children were screened for BMI, head circumference and mid arm circumference.
- All children were examined and given prescriptions for various health conditions like rhinitis, URTI, gastroenteritis, ASOM, scabies, fungal infections, anemia etc.
- Patients requiring advanced treatment were advised to visit higher Centre (Santosh Hospital) for respective specialty.

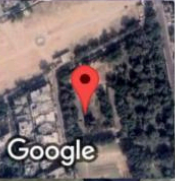
