 - (g) Results
 - (h) Conclusion

- Inclusion of abstract in the scientific program will be considered only after the receipt of registration fees.
- Abstracts should be submitted in good English and abstract with grammatical syntax errors will not be accepted.
- Abstract of your work should not exceed 250 words, typed in Times New Roman with Font size of 12 for body and 14 for title.
- Abstract should be submitted in word file only named as Abstract, oral/poster (name of Applicant).
