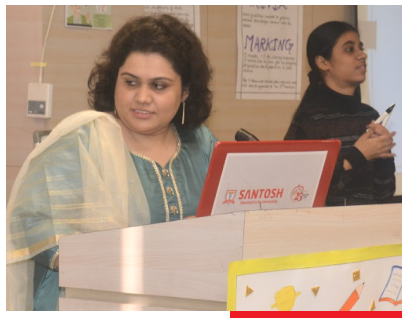

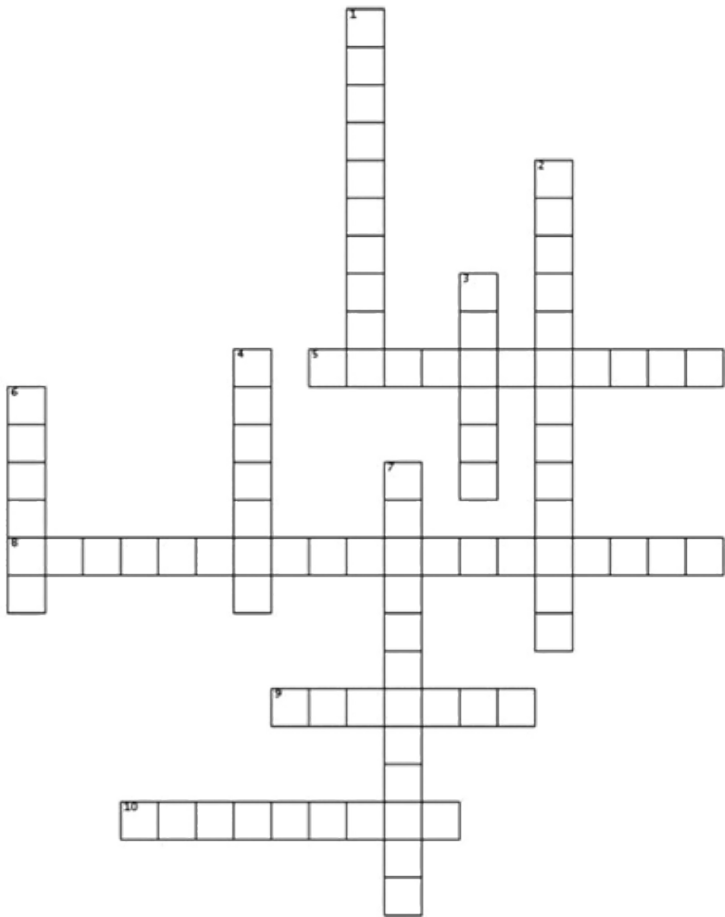

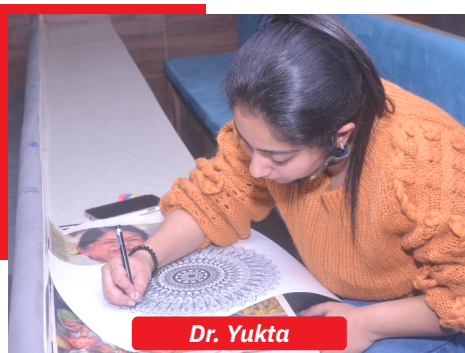

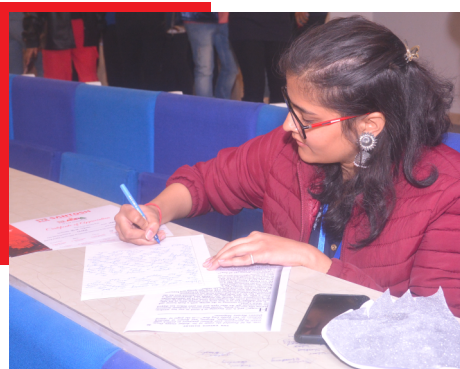

REJOICING SUCCESS

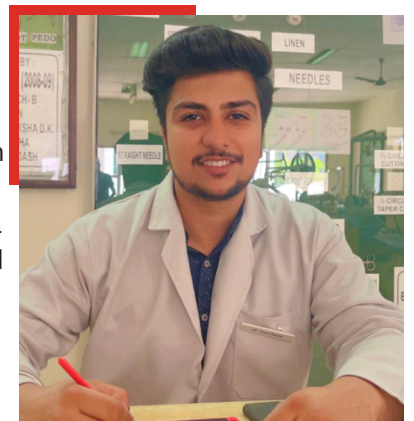
